

WEE JEST is great for learning about things you can do with just neutral and black polymer clay

This is the second part of a three (or perhaps four) part series called "WEE JEST"

Things you will need:

- Polymer clay: a blend or beige and black. I use Premo by Scupey for teaching
- Sculpting tools
- Straight pin
- Exacto knife
- Apple stick or large barbecue shish kabob stick
- Makeup or chalk pastels various colours of your choice
- Brushes for putting the colour on to the clay

Now we can begin:

- Mix and condition your clay: click on the link below for the tutorial on how

- Start with a ball of black clay about the size of a large marble
- Press it into the back of the head you finished last week and "sit" it onto the head like a hat.
- Once in position prepare two smaller balls (small marbles approx) for the triangular bits on the hat.
- Make the shape and then press the polymer clay on to the hat. Add details as you wish for decoration.

Colour the clay as you wish using your palette and makeup and/or pastels. Pan Pastels are amazing for intense colours.

Cure and finish your head.
